The Fishing Derby takes place annually in June on the Saturday during Illinois DNR Free Fishing Weekend. The pond is stocked with over seven hundred pounds of catfish during the week preceding the event. This event requires registration either before the event or on-site the day of the event. Participants fish from 8am-10:30am trying to catch the longest fish in their age category. The top three fish in each age category receive prizes and certificates. In addition, the angler who catches the albino catfish also receives a prize. Participants and onlookers can purchase drinks and snacks from a vendor and participate in drawings by purchasing tickets. The event is concluded with an awards presentation.
