



Ganster Pool Rules

1. If there is an emergency situation please do not interfere with the pool staff. They are responsible for responding to emergencies and implementing first aid when necessary.
2. Children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by someone 18 years or older at all times in and out of the water.
3. Proper swimming attire must be worn at all times. Children who are not toilet trained must wear swim diapers.
4. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved life jackets are permitted, and only with parental/adult supervision.
5. All swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
6. All food and drink must be kept in the concession area only. No glass allowed.
7. Please do not run, push, or engage in any horseplay.
8. Use of profane language will not be tolerated.
9. No diving is permitted except off the diving boards in the diving well.
10. Please observe posted diving board rules.
11. The pool will be closed for 30 minutes if there is lightning, thunder or a steady rain.
12. The Waukegan Park District is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
13. The Waukegan Park District pool staff has the right to enforce these rules and those more stringent that supplement the rules listed above.



Diving Board Rules

1. A swim test is required for all persons using the diving board.
2. Patrons must wait their turn at the bottom of the ladder.
3. Only one diver at a time is permitted on the board.
4. The diving board is the only entrance to the diving area in the pool.
5. Only jumping or diving straight off the end of the board is permitted.
6. No running takeoffs.
7. Only one bounce is permitted.
8. All divers must look before and wait until the area in the pool is clear before diving.
9. Immediately after diving, the diver must surface and swim clear of the diving area.
10. Goggles are not allowed.
11. All diving board equipment may be adjusted only by Aquatics personnel.
12. Any activities deemed unsafe by the Aquatics personnel are not permitted.
