

Black and White: The Art of the Pencil Supply List

Course Description

Students in this class will learn how powerful the most basic elements of drawing can be. The class will study composition, perspective, line quality, value, shadow, light, and movement, all with an eye towards creating dramatic and meaningful representations of our physical world. Using pencils, charcoal, and paper, students will discover the possibilities inherent in the most humble of drawing materials. This class is appropriate for students with all levels of experience.

Supply List:

Drawing Pencils- HB, 2B, 4B, and 6B

Charcoal Pencils in soft, medium, and hard (peel and sketch type if possible)

Compressed Charcoal in soft and hard; or 2B and 6B

Kneaded Gum Paper

Pencil Eraser

Utility Knife

Drafting Tape

Pad of Newsprint paper, minimum size of 12x16

One pad or 8 pieces of drawing paper, minimum size of 12x16

One pad or 8 pieces of charcoal paper, minimum size of 12x16
