## Young People’s Concert

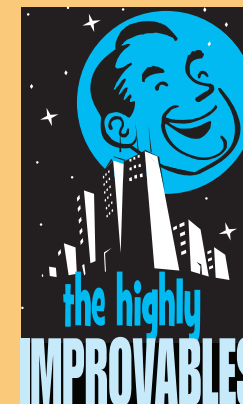

## Bowen Park Theatre Company

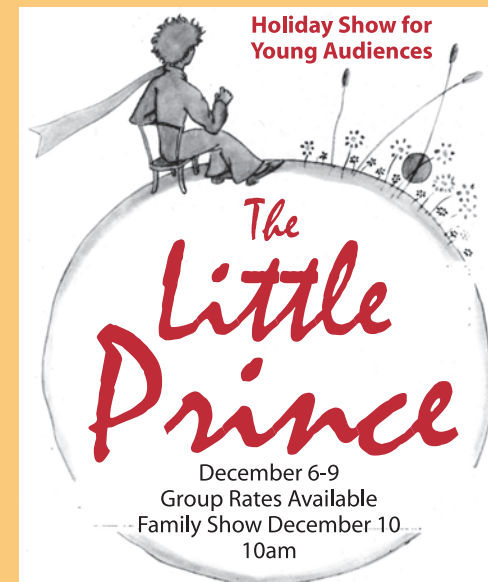

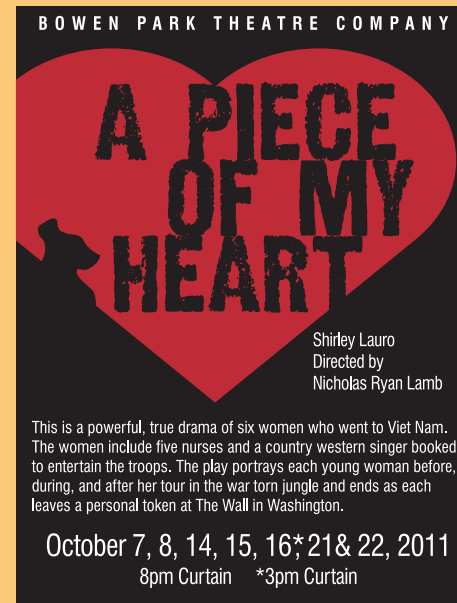

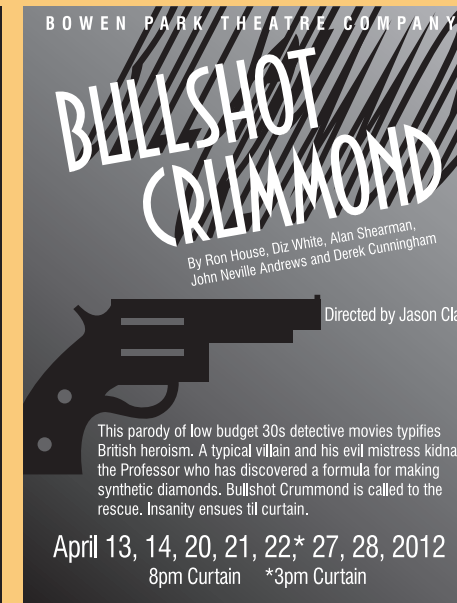
