High Tea at the Old Victorian Farmhouse (21 years & older) \$39/\$43

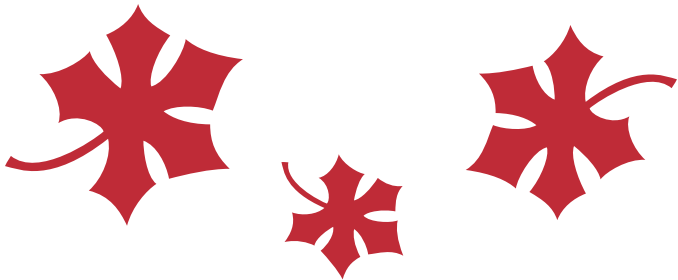
