SECTION I: In pursuance of authority vested in them by Chapter 70 ILCS, 1205, the Commissioners of the Park District in meeting assembled, do hereby find and declare that there will be required to be raised by general taxation the amounts hereinafter, set down, to be levied upon all the taxable property in said Park District, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Park District as required by statute or voted by people in accordance with law, and the amounts so required are itemized and needed for uses and purposes as follows to-wit:

PART I - GENERAL FUND for payment of necessary expenses and liabilities for general corporate purposes under 70 ILCS 1205/5-1 and 1205/5-3.

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PART IX - FUND FOR PAVING AND LIGHTING STREETS AND ROADWAYS for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, and lighting streets and roadways and within the parks and playgrounds maintained by the District under 70 ILCS 1205/5-6.

SECTION II: Making the aggregate sum Eight Million Eight Hundred Twenty Four Thousand, and 00/100 Dollars (8,824,000) to be raised by taxation and levied on all the taxable property in said Park District, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Park District as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with law.

SECTION III: That the taxes so levied and assessed as aforesaid by this ordinance upon the taxable property subject to taxes within the Waukegan Park District shall be collected and enforced in the same manner and by the same officers as general taxes are now collected and enforced for the city and village purposes in the County of Lake, State of Illinois, under the laws of the State of Illinois, and shall be paid over by the officer so collecting the same to the Treasurer of the Waukegan Park District.


SECTION IV: That the Secretary of the Waukegan Park District be and he is hereby directed to file with the County Clerk of Lake County, Illinois, within the time limit prescribed by law, a copy of this tax levy ordinance duly certified by him.

SECTION V: That the County Clerk of Lake County, State of Illinois, be and he is hereby directed as provided by law to ascertain the rate per cent which, upon the total valuation of all property subject to taxation within the Waukegan Park District as the same is assessed and equalized for the State and County purposes, will produce a net income as herein legally levied and to extend such tax pursuant to the statute.

SECTION VI: If any item or portion thereof of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION VII: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with any section hereof are hereby modified or repealed.

SECTION VIII: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, signing and recording, as provided by law.






