3.12 RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

The Waukegan Park District resident is a person whose home is within the boundaries of the park district. Residency is the permanent and principal address of the individual occupying the home, apartment, condominium or estate. The resident must produce two (2) forms of identification showing address to verify eligibility to purchase a resident permit (e.g. driver's license & current utility bill). Anyone submitting false or misleading information about residency shall have their playing privileges revoked. No refunds will be granted for any fees or charges incurred. With regard to golf passes, to restore playing privileges, a \$100 processing fee must be paid in addition to the difference between a resident and a non-resident pass.

Rental Property: Owners of rental property who reside outside the park district boundaries are considered non-resident. The property is rented to others who may be classified as Waukegan Park District residents because they have established permanent residency at the location.

Commercial Property: Owners of commercial property who reside outside the park district are considered non-resident.
