Private Music Instruction

The Jack Benny Center for the Arts offers private lessons in piano, traditional violin, viola, cello, mandolin, banjo, ukelele, string bass, guitar, woodwinds, brass, dulcimer and voice. Lessons are scheduled individually and prices vary with instructors. Jack Benny Center for the Arts offers five sessions of eight-week lessons annually. Please call the Center at 847-360-4740 for dates, times, and availability of lessons. Jack Benny Center does not rent instruments or sell music books. Students must be able to practice lessons on a daily basis and have the recommended music book and instrument. Some group lessons may need to be combined to meet minimum registration. Students are called one week before lessons if a class has not met its minimum.

Scholarships

Stage One

Stage One, for ages 8-13, is a fun and challenging class where students learn skills through theatre games and improvisation activities, as well as through the rehearsal and performance of a play.

Private Acting

If you need help on an audition piece, a scene or just want to take acting lessons, Jason Clark will work one-on-one with students for one hour per week at the Jack Benny Center. Times are arranged with the instructor.

Compass Creative Dramatics

Students stretch their creativity and bravery muscles through rehearsals and workshops in topics like improvisation and stage combat taught by Chicago theatre professionals. Students perform alongside two professional actor/educators, who lead by example, helping children shine through the experience of live performance. Compass Creative Dramatics holds workshops and classes throughout the year at the Jack Benny Center for the Arts and at the Visual Arts Center. We encourage students **to take creative risks** and **trust without self-judgment**, stretching their **creativity** and **bravery** "muscles" as they develop social skills like **teamwork**, **respect**, and **empathy** through their exploration of theatre.
