This program's main areas of focus include: Health, Education, Art, Recreation, and Training. Structured programs are designed to improve its participants' quality of life through meaningful and educational experiences.

Applicants for the program must:

- · Be 18 years and older
- · Be a high school graduate
- Complete the intake process to determine eligibility and participant program needs
- Sign a release of information form
- Function at a ratio of 6 participants to 1 staff
- Submit a \$30 deposit at time of application. *Deposit is refunded if participant is not eligible for the program or program does not run.
- **This program is ideal for adults who work part-time, are unemployed or who want something different from the traditional workshop environment.
