Waukegan Park District Annual Fishing Derby on Saturday, June 3 at Bevier Pond

WAUKEGAN, IL (May 25, 2017) The Waukegan Park District Annual Fishing Derby will be held on Saturday, June 3, 2017 at the pond in Bevier Park from 8-10:30am. The Waukegan Park District has been granted a “free fishing day” as declared by the Illinois Department of Natural Resources; therefore, no state fishing licenses are required for the event at Bevier Pond. Prior to the Derby, Bevier is stocked with several hundred pounds of catfish. Great prizes are awarded according to age categories for the largest fish caught. Pre-registration is highly encouraged as the event has become increasingly popular as a family outing. Cultural events are provided by the Waukegan Symphony Orchestra and Concert Chorus, and the Waukegan History Museum. There is something for everyone! The award-winning District employs 61 full-time and over 230 part-time, year round, seasonal, and temporary employees. The District is a member of the National Recreation and Park Association (NRPA), Illinois Association of Park Districts (IAPD), and Illinois Park and Recreation Association (IPRA). The district maintains national accreditation from the NRPA Commission for Accreditation of Park and Recreation Agencies (CAPRA), Illinois Association of Park Districts (IAPD) Distinguished Agency accreditation and Park District Risk Management Agency (PDRMA) accreditation and maintains a Level A Loss Control Program. The district was a NRPA Gold Medal Finalist in 2012 and 2013, and awarded the NRPA National Gold Medal Award for Excellence in Park and Recreation Management in 2013.
