Families Get Fit with Parent/Child Pilates & FitKids Field House Sports & Fitness Center Waukegan Park District

Waukegan, IL (**November 27, 2007**) – The Waukegan Park District's Field House Sports and Fitness Center is now offering fresh new approach to physical fitness! Registration is now open for two new youth fitness programs – Mommy/Daddy & Me Pilates and FitKids! These programs are specifically targeted to children ages 4 – 10 years old (Pilates) and 7 – 13 years old (FitKids), and they encourage a family's appreciation for the benefits of daily physical activity. All classes are held at the Field House and are taught by Certified Fitness Instructors.

Mommy/Daddy and Me Pilates is offered Thursday evenings from 6 – 7 PM for youth ages 4-10 years old and a parent. Children and parents together will learn Pilates exercises through various games and activities that will increase core strength and flexibility. Parents can enjoy some together time with their children and everyone gets to exercise and receive the benefits of physical fitness. Mommy/Daddy and Me Pilates starts on January 12 and ends February 21.

FitKids is offered Saturday mornings from 9 -10 AM at the Field House. A Certified Fitness Instructor will guide participants through an hour-long variety of fun, physical activities that will not seem like exercises. They will use balls, bands, hula hoops, jump ropes, games and much more to create a positive and supportive environment that focuses on physical movement and active play. The next FitKids session starts January 12 and ends February 23.
