Camp spots cannot be held that are pending approval for third party payments or financial aid.

Registration

• Sign up for each session of day camp you would like your child to attend. Enrollment in one session does not guarantee a spot in future sessions. You must register in advance by the session deadline.

• Before and after care is available only for campers in Rangers, Explorers and Teen Quest. After care is available for Kaleidoscope Kids Camps. Sign-up and preregistration are required for before/after care. Children are not to be dropped off early or picked up late.

Camp Handbook/Registration Form

Parent camp handbooks are provided at registration for camp. This book contains valuable information that you need to know about our camps. Registration and medical forms must be filled out at registration. Handbooks and registration forms can also be downloaded at our website at www.waukeganparks.org.

Waiting List

If a camp session is full, we will be happy to place your name and phone number on a waiting list. If you are placed on a waiting list, you will be called when a camp spot opens. There is a limited amount of time to contact us to accept or decline the opening. The next person on the list will be called if an opening is declined or response time has passed. A working phone number to reach the parent/guardian is necessary. If the parent/guardian cannot be reached or we are unable to leave a message, the next person on the list will be called. Calls will be documented.

What to Bring to Camp

Backpack or bag labeled with name

• Afternoon snack (Park District will again be participating in the Summer Food Program in which breakfast and lunch will be provided through the Northern Illinois Food Bank). Breakfast will be available for campers registered in Before Care and lunch will be available for campers registered in Belvidere Park Explorers, Bowen Park Rangers and Teen Quest camps.

- Towels and swimsuit on swim and water play days
- Empty plastic bag (for wet suits and towels)
- Extra set of clothes, in case of an emergency
- Labeled water bottle
- Sunscreen

No toys or any item of value which may be easily lost or broken. We cannot assume responsibility for any lost toys, Game Boys, radios, cell phones, etc., brought to camp
 Label all of your child's belongings with their name

What to Wear to Camp

Dress your child appropriately for the weather and for outdoor play. Please send your camper in gym shoes rather than sandals.

Medication

• If your child requires medication, a doctor's note stating the need for medicine must be submitted prior to the start of camp. Parent/guardian must also sign the medicine waiver/release form.

• Staff holds all medication. Medication must be in a child safety capped, prescription bottle, labeled with child's name, phone number, dosage amount and time. We cannot assume full responsibility for medicine administration. Parents are encouraged to administer medicine in the early morning before camp if possible. Staff are only permitted to hold daily doses of medication.

Camp Fees*

Camp fees include program staff trips, craft supplies, swimming admission, etc.
A \$30 nonrefundable deposit is needed to hold a spot for FULL DAY CAMPS and DISCOVERY DAY CAMP ONLY. The deposit is credited to the specified session's remaining balance. Whether paying in full or placing a deposit, cancellation of a registration (for each session a child is removed from) will result in the loss of the \$30.00 deposit.
Half-day camp (Kaleidoscope Kids, Discovery Camp, Let's Move Sports and Fitness Camp) fees must be paid in full at the time of registration.



• Final Payments: Final payment is required by the registration deadline in order to retain a child's camp spot.

• The registration deadline and final payments are due generally three weeks before a camp session begins.

• \$30 deposit for FULL DAY camps and DISCOVERY DAY CAMP only. The \$30 deposit is nonrefundable.

• We are unable to prorate the fee for missed days because of vacation or illness.

• Sibling discounts are available! Families with more than one child living in the same household will receive a discount for each child attending camp.

Sample Camp Payment Schedule for Full Day Camps:


