Milwaukee Zoo

May 21, 2016

Visit the Zoo and bring the kids too! The Milwaukee County Zoo houses 1,800 animals and covers an area of 200 acres. Known for its polar bears, gorillas and cheetahs, the zoo is also home to one of the largest groups of bonobos in one location outside their native Democratic Republic of the Congo. This visit to the zoo will feature a wildlife presentation, boxed lunches, and two tickets to use on your choice of ride or attraction including the Train, Zoomobile, Sea Lion Show, or Carousel. Fee is \$39 for adults and \$35 for children under 12. Fees include transportation, entry, lunch and two ride/attraction tickets. The trip departs Park Place at 9 a.m. and returns around 3:30 p.m.
