High School Art Studio Supply List

Course Description

In this class, students will collaborate with the instructor to develop projects that match interests. The class will focus on helping students improve technical skills as well as find their artistic "voice" within their chosen medium. The last 20-30 minutes of each class will be reserved for critique and discussion of students' ongoing work. Students are asked to bring a sketchbook and pencils or charcoal to the first class, and will create a customized supply list with the instructor during the first class. Some previous experience in the visual arts is preferred, but not required.

Supply list:

Pad of Drawing Paper
3-4 drawing pencils or pieces or charcoal and erasers
Jar of "Yes paste" or rubber cement and brush
Scissors

Set of artist quality paints and brushes-artists with experience are welcome to bring whatever painting materials they already own. For new artists, acrylic paints are recommended in the following colors:

Alizarin Crimson
Hansa Yellow Opaque or Cadmium Yellow medium
Ultramarine Blue
Viridian Green
Sap Green Hue
Raw Umber
Burnt Sienna
Titanium White

Students will be asked to bring other "found" materials to be discussed at the first class meeting. Students may also need to purchase additional materials as determined by their final projects.
