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Illinois Relay Center

The Illinois Relay Center enables people who have speech impairments or who are deaf or hard of hearing who use a TDD to contact persons without a TDD, and vice-versa, at no cost. Full Access For All – ADA

Resident and Non-Resident Fees

Residents support Waukegan Park District programs, facilities and services through property taxes. Therefore, residents pay reduced fees and non-residents generally pay greater fees. Waukegan Park District boundaries encompass areas outside of the City of Waukegan boundaries. People living within the Park District boundaries pay taxes to the District and are therefore considered Waukegan Park District residents. The quickest way to determine your Park District resident status is to check your residence property tax bill, which lists the park district you pay taxes to or call the Park District at 847-360-4700.

Participant Behavior Guidelines

Please be advised that fighting, rough play, threatening bodily harm, disorderly conduct, profanity and disrespect of staff or others are prohibited. Violations may lead to immediate removal from facility. The Waukegan Park District reserves the right to revoke membership and/or daily privileges for failure to abide by the rules and regulations without refund.

Be A Good Neighbor

Please respect the rights and property of the neighbors living by the parks! A few reminders:

- Use the sidewalks and pathways when walking to parks. Cutting through private yards is not appropriate.
- Trees, bushes, fences, etc. should not be used as bathrooms. We suggest family members use their own bathrooms before visiting parks.
- Trash should be discarded into trash cans in the park. When not put into cans, it often blows into neighbors' yards.

Park Security Program


When visiting a park you may notice a police officer patrolling the area. The Waukegan Park District and the City of Waukegan have a cooperative program to increase security in our park system and facilities. Off-duty police are hired to patrol parks and routinely walk through the parks, visit programs and assist park users. Also, throughout the day and night regular police officers make patrols during their normal shift. If you witness a crime or vandalism occurring in a park or golf course, please report it immediately to the Waukegan Police Department, 847-360-9000, or the Waukegan Park District, 847-360-4725. If the incident constitutes an emergency, please dial 911.

Vandalism

Each year, the Waukegan Park District suffers thousands of dollars worth of damage from vandalism, and these costs are absorbed by the taxpayers. If you witness vandalism, please notify the police at 847-599-2608, or call the Parks Department at 847-360-4725 with any information that could lead to the apprehension of the vandals.

By Mail Registration

- 1. Clip out the registration form and fill it out completely. Be sure the program ID number is correct. This is how we determine which program you desire.
- 2. Mail the form along with a check or money order to the address listed. Please be sure that the check or money order is payable for the exact amount. Please do not pay by cash for mail-in registration.

In-Person Registration

In-person registration for Park District residents takes place at the Belvidere Recreation Center, Field House Sports & Fitness Center and Jack Benny Center for the Arts.

Program Changes and Cancellations

- Programs are sometimes cancelled or altered due to low registration or changes in staff or facility availability.
- You are entitled to a full refund for a program that has been cancelled by the Park District. Refunds will usually be issued usually within 7-14 days, in accordance with our Accounts Payable schedule.

Remember

- Online and mail-in registrations receive priority. If you want to be sure to get into a popular program this is the way to do it.
- We cannot accept any registration by phone (unless otherwise specified).
- We will take waiting lists for programs that are filled and expand a class maximum if possible.
- We may require proof of your Park District residency.
- VISA, Discover and MasterCard are accepted in-person only.
- Cancellations initiated by patrons prior to the start of a program are entitled to a refund, less applicable service charges. Refunds will be issued usually within 7-14 business days, in accordance with our Accounts Payable schedule.
- · We do not give refunds for programs after they have started.
- We charge a \$10 fee for withdrawing from a program to cover administrative expenses.
