This course is designed by Medic First Aid, a worldwide leader in CPR, AED and First Aid emergency care training programs. **Upon successful completion of the course, students will receive CPR and First Aid certification for infants, children, and adults valid for two years. This class will satisfy any child care requirements.** A written test is not required but students must be able to physically participate in all skill practices.
