WAUKEGAN PARK DISTRICT Team Instructions

Hazard Hunt

The focus is on SLIP and TRIP hazards.

Hunt for hazards in parking lots, sidewalks, buildings, and parks.

Identify Hazard

Recreation, Cultural Arts, and Administration Facilities have kits. (Non-Parkie category)

- Inform a supervisor if you find a hazard – take a “before” picture of the hazard
- Together use contents of the kit to identify OR correct the hazard – take an “after” picture of identification / correction

Parks staff use the supplies they have.

- Inform crew leader if you find a hazard – take a “before” picture
- Together use supplies to identify OR correct hazard – take an “after” picture

Document

Email entry to PDRMA hazardhunter@pdrma.org and to tbrady@waukeganparks.org

Include:

- “Before” picture & “After” picture
- WAUKEGAN HAZARD HUNTER in the subject line
- Agency name (Waukegan Park District)
- Employee’s Department
- Name and job title of employee making the entry
- Supervisor’s name
- Date of entry
- Location of hazard (name of park or facility)
- Suggested corrective action

Supervisor can then submit any necessary work orders to have hazard corrected.

Claim Victory!
