Swim Lessons for Youth with Disabilities: OTTERS

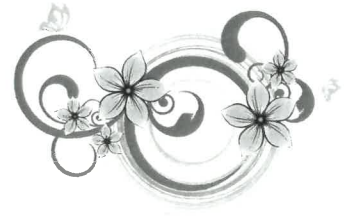
Tired of feeling like an otter out of water? Swimming is an essential life skill for safety, fitness and fun! Special Recreation is offering swimming lessons for children with special needs. All lessons are based on the SwimSmart Program, but are designed around the individual swimmer. Whether your goal is to just get comfortable in the water, support sensory experiences or become a competitive swimmer, Special Recreation can guide you along the way. We encourage you to jump on in; the water's great!



Lessons are 30 minutes and have a maximum group size of 2 swimmers to one instructor. Swim times are offered on Saturdays for 6 weeks between 9:00am and 1:00pm or Thursday for 8 weeks between 6:00pm and 7:45pm. Times will be assigned based on instructor availability and space in the pool. Registrants will receive time assignments one week before class. Please contact Kari at 847-360-4763 to complete an initial assessment of your child's current skill level.
