

**WAUKEGAN PARK DISTRICT
ORDINANCE NUMBER 2019-03**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE REGULATING PERSONAL
CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOR IN WAUKEGAN PARK DISTRICT'S PARKS, TO
PROHIBIT THE USE OF CAMERAS IN CERTAIN FACILITIES**

WHEREAS, the Waukegan Park District, Lake County, Illinois (the "District"), has previously adopted an Ordinance Codifying Rules and Regulations Pertaining to the Control of Persons and Activities and Conduct in the Waukegan Park District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8-1 of the Park District Code (70 ILCS 1205/8-1(d)), every park district is authorized to establish by ordinance all needful rules and regulations for the government and protection of parks and, Section 8-10 of the Park District Code (70 ILCS 1205/8-10), to make and enforce reasonable rules, regulations, and charges therefor; and **WHEREAS**, the District has periodically amended the Conduct Ordinance by the adoption of subsequent ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the District has determined that it is in the District's best interest to amend CHAPTER 6 - REGULATIONS OF PERSONAL CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOR, with the adoption of Section 15, a new provision that prohibits the use of Cell Phones and Recording Devices.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the corporate authorities of Waukegan Park District the following:

SECTION 1: That pursuant to authority granted to the Park District under 70 ILCS 1205/8-1 & 8-10, promulgate the following:

Section 15 - Prohibits the Use of Cellular Phones and Recording Devices

No Person shall bring or use or operate (i) any still camera, television or movie camera, camcorder, video recorder or transmitter or any other device capable of recording, filming or transmitting visual images; or (ii) use or operate any cellular telephone, in any restroom, locker room or washroom facility, anywhere on District Property.

SECTION 2: Any person, who violates any provision of this Ordinance, may be punished by a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000).

SECTION 3: The Board President and the Board Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to execute said Ordinance, on behalf of the Waukegan Park District.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption as provided by law.

SECTION 5: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION 6: In lieu of publications, this Ordinance shall be published in book or pamphlet form, and when so published shall become effective with the same force and effect as if otherwise published. Such book or pamphlet shall be evidence of the passage and legal publication of this ordinance in all courts without further proof, as provided by law.
