The District has been both locally and nationally recognized. With only 8.2% of property tax bills funding the District, this unit of local government does more with less than other units. The District also generates revenue for the State and other local municipalities. He reviewed the items that are available on the website, which promote transparency to all residents. Mr. Beckmann finished by providing an overview of the awards the District has received.
